

YHAI Adventure Activities

Growth in YHAI National Adventure Programs.


There was appreciable growth of approximately 38% in the number of programs from 26 National Adventure programs in 2018-19 to 36 National Adventure programs in 2019-20 organised by the National Office.



2020-2021: Due to outbreak of Covid-19, the lockdown was imposed by the Government in the year 2020 and 2021, therefore, summer programs of 2020 and 2021 were cancelled. Accordingly, only 13 programs were organised in the year 2020-21.

Accordingly Income and Surplus of these two years has been reduced.

Number of participants in YHAI National Adventure Programs



YHAI focused and improved the overall quality of the adventure programs. The pandemic corona virus affected the participation in the year 2020 and 2021. For the safety of the members, YHAI National Office called off all national adventure programs from April to October 2020 and from April to June, 2021. Only programs in Leh and one program in North East States was organised in May-June, 2021 as there was no lockdown.



Enhancement of Facilities & Activities in Camp Sites

Purchasing of New Equipment

With the growth in the number of national adventure programs, YHAI purchased new tents, Sleeping bags, toilet tents, Mattresses, rucksacks and other technical equipment and improved overall quality of the adventure programs.











Installation of RO water Filters in Base Camps

YHAI installed RO water filters in all YHAI base camps of adventure programs for keeping hygiene in the camps and safety of the health of the participants.





Utilization of Helicopters in high altitude rescue operations



For the safety of YHAI members in YHAI trekking expeditions, YHAI engaged helicopters many times due to emergencies to rescue the stranded participants while trekking in high altitude in Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh.



Installation of Solar Panels at camp sites

YHAI started installing temporary solar panels at higher camps to ensure the possible comfort for the participants and make trekking more eco-friendly.



Installation of Rope Setup adventure

With the aim to promote the sense of adventure in young students and to overcome the fear factors in youngsters participating in Nature Study programs, YHAI installed the rope setup at Dobhi Base Camp offering numbers of adventure activities.



Workshop on Interpersonal Skills Training and Medical Emergencies

To enhance the interpersonal skills of the Staff, Field Directors and volunteers engaged in the National Adventure Programs, YHAI organized **Interpersonal Skills Training** at National Office on 10th November 2018 which was followed by the training session on Medical Emergencies expected in high altitude trekking and their remedies.

Introduced innovative colorful Two and Four Men Tents

After pandemic YHAI introduced new colorful two and four men tents in trekking programs and started its implementation from Kedarkantha and Brahmatal Winter Trekking Expeditions in December/January 2020-2021. These colorful two and four men tents not only ensured the social distancing but also decorated our camp sites professionally which is the main attraction for trekkers and travellers.




Introduced YHAI Weekend programs


Inauguration of International Youth Hostel Darjeeling

An MoU is signed between YHAI and NYHT for the construction of International Youth Hostel Gopalpur. YHAI initiated the process of construction of the Hostel.




According to the need of the day, YHAI focused on the quality and standards of accommodation instead of quantity of the hostels. During quality inspections, the LYH which were not maintaining the proper quality standards, were removed from the List of LYH of Association to keep the hostelling standards up to date to fulfill the needs of the hostellers.

Due to outbreak of Covid-19, no new LYH joined YHAI in 2021.

YHAI Environment Programs

Installation of Grid connected Solar Panels at International Youth Hostel Mysuru

To reduce the carbon footprints of the hostel in terms of energy consumption and to contribute the overall energy generated by the government, YHAI installed the grid connected solar panels at International Youth Hostel Mysuru. The project not only reduced the monthly expanses of the hostel in terms of electricity bills but also demonstrated our collective efforts to achieve and promote sustainability. The panels cover around 4000 sqft. area and is having the capacity to generate 60000 KW of electricity approximately per vear.



YHA India winner in Hostelling International Sustainability Fund 2020

In the competition of HI Sustainability Fund 2020, YHA India represented solar power project and implemented at International Youth Hostel Mysuru. Eight national associations participated in international voting and YHA India got the first prize by securing 1693 votes out of 3000. YHA India got prize of £4,253 (Rs 4,25,049/-).



Clean Kedarkantha, Uttarakhand

While conducting the adventure programs in Himalayas, YHAI focused to make the programs eco friendly and run a campaign Clean Kedarkantha in Uttarakhand. During this campaign, very huge plastic and other garbage was collected from the trekking trails and was handed over to the concerned authorities.






International Youth Convention 2019

Complimentary accommodation to Health Workers in International Youth Hostel, New Delhi during Covid-19

International Youth Hostel received a request from Govt. of NCT of Delhi regarding utilising the hostel as quarantine centre for the health workers. Accordingly, whole hostel was sanitized to provide them from April to June, 2020. A number of health workers stayed in the Hostel and some of them were infected with Covid-19 positive.

The Staff of NYHT rendered tremendous services to them by working in lockdown. The health workers were provided all the services and food nicely and Government also appreciated the hospitality of NYHT staff.




